Basic Requirements for attendance @ Rotary

1. Members are expected to meet the minimum attendance requirements to benefit from membership in Rotary. The basic requirements are as follows:
 - Attend or make up at least 50% of your Rotary Club meetings in each half of the Rotary year.
 - Attend at least 30% of your Clubs meetings in each half of the year.
 - A member may not miss, or fail to make up, four consecutive meetings.
 - You should be present for 60% of a Club meeting for it to count towards the attendance requirement.

2. Make ups and attendance credits are obtained as follows:
 - Attend a meeting of another club (two weeks before or two weeks after the meeting missed at your Club).
 - Attend a meeting of a Rotaract or Interact Club, Rotary Community Corps or Rotary Fellowship.
 - Participate in a Club sponsored event or service project (Club sponsored community event, Spruce Meadows, etc).
 - Attend at a Club board or service committee meeting with authorization of the Board of Directors.
 - Participate in an e-mail meeting of Rotary for at least 30 minutes.

3. Make ups with other Clubs around the world helps in the following ways:
 - Meet a new group of Rotarians
 - Observe how another Club operates
 - Share information about your Club
 - Make international contacts for Club projects

Finding another Club for a make up can be achieved by Rotary's Official Directory of Clubs, or using Rotary Online Club Locator. Ask your Club secretary for help. When attending another Club, get a sign-up card or note as proof of your attendance for all Clubs outside of the Calgary area. Place a note on the back of your meal ticket to advise the attendance committee of any make ups you do.
